We attended an opening new congregation at Udon province.

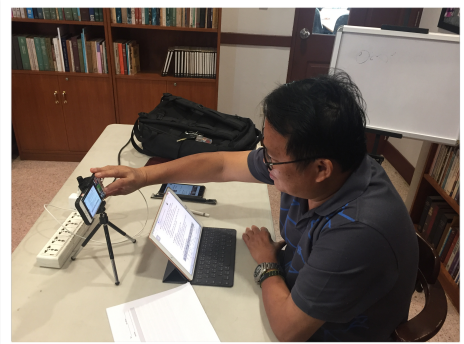

Brother Patinya is a founder and an instructor of BSLI.

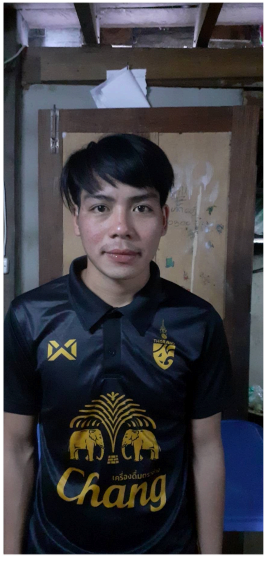


Sister Penpun (Nong) was a class of 2's BSLI students. She has been graduated since 2002. She teaches an conversational English.

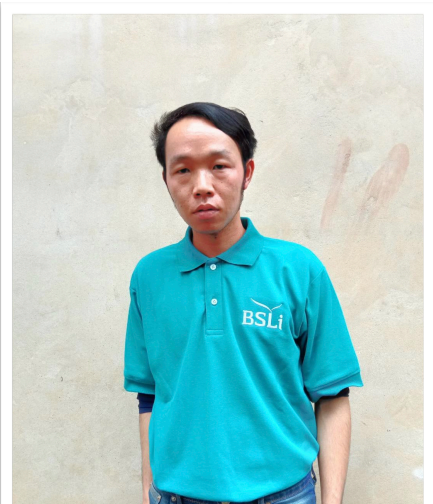

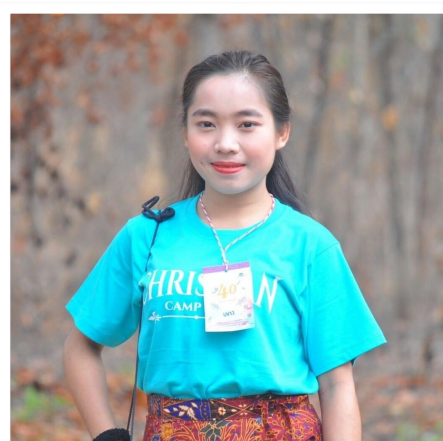
