## MINISTRY AND VOCATIONAL TRAINING OUTCOMES

Duncan Ojiambo, who leads four Bible colleges in Uganda, reported that he had purchased food for the Karamoja Bible and Vocational School and visited three of the brick laying students on their new construction site. "I was amazed by what I saw," he said. "God, through NLBI, has really transformed these servants. The community is keeping them busy after discovering that they know how to build. They are constructing a house for one of the local government leaders in their community. They are trusted because they are Christian masons. Keep us in your prayers as we continue to equip more students."





### PRISON MINISTRY RESULTS

Trainer Stephen Misiko serves many souls in Kenyan prisons. He commented, “We praise God for His grace. God has enabled us to have a very fruitful training event with both men and women behind bars. ## ENCOURAGING YOUTH TO BECOME MORE LIKE JESUS

Ephraim Phiri leads several areas of ministry in Zambia, including teaching high school students about Jesus. "350 high school students and 10 teachers were taught the (NLBI lesson) 'Sense of Self.' I began by meeting with the District Education Board secretary, the person in charge of schools in the district, to present the NLBI curriculum. He was very pleased with it and encouraged me to visit as many schools as possible so that more high school students will get to learn this lesson. After meeting with the school administration, students were organized at an assembly space outside because the classroom I was given was too small to accommodate everyone."
