"The love of the Messiah controls us, for we are convinced of this: that one person died for all people; therefore, all people have died. He died for all people, so that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for the one who died and rose for them. So then, from now on we do not think of anyone from a human point of view. Even if we did think of the Messiah from a human point of view, we don't think of him that way anymore. Therefore, if anyone is in the Messiah, he is a new creation. Old things have disappeared, and—look!—all things have become new! All of this comes from God, who has reconciled us to himself through the Messiah and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, for through the Messiah, God was reconciling the world to himself by not counting their sins against them. He has committed his message of reconciliation to us. Therefore, we are the Messiah's representatives, as though God were pleading through us. We plead on the Messiah's behalf: "Be reconciled to God!" 2 Cor 5:14-20

One of my relatives who is very close to me asked, "Why do you serve God?" After year of working in Thailand and Laos, it is easily for me to get up in the morning and just do "The routine." I started to work as I was programed in my mind. The passage above reminds me to evaluate myself. I found three reasons in this important passage: "The Love of The Messiah" My Jesus died for me to do what I am doing, to give me strength when I am weary and to give me hope for the eternity (Rom 5:6-8). "A New Creature" First, I am a new man belong to Christ not myself. I am still here on earth to serve Him. Second, it is always a great joy to see new baby in Christ. Think with me for a second to the time to see your own child for the first time after his or her birth. God fills your heart with the kind of joy you never have before in your life. The same joy happen every time in your heart when you see a person was born spiritually at the baptism (Eph 4:23-24). "We are ambassadors of Christ" My best friend from Arkansas likes the phrase "Appreciate the opportunity". Thank about it. I was a sinner and still is. He washed my sins, and He raised me up to the honorable position to represent heaven. Listen, to represent the heaven which is more than just representing a country. All of us on the Thai Lao for the Savior team love to serve our Messiah.


