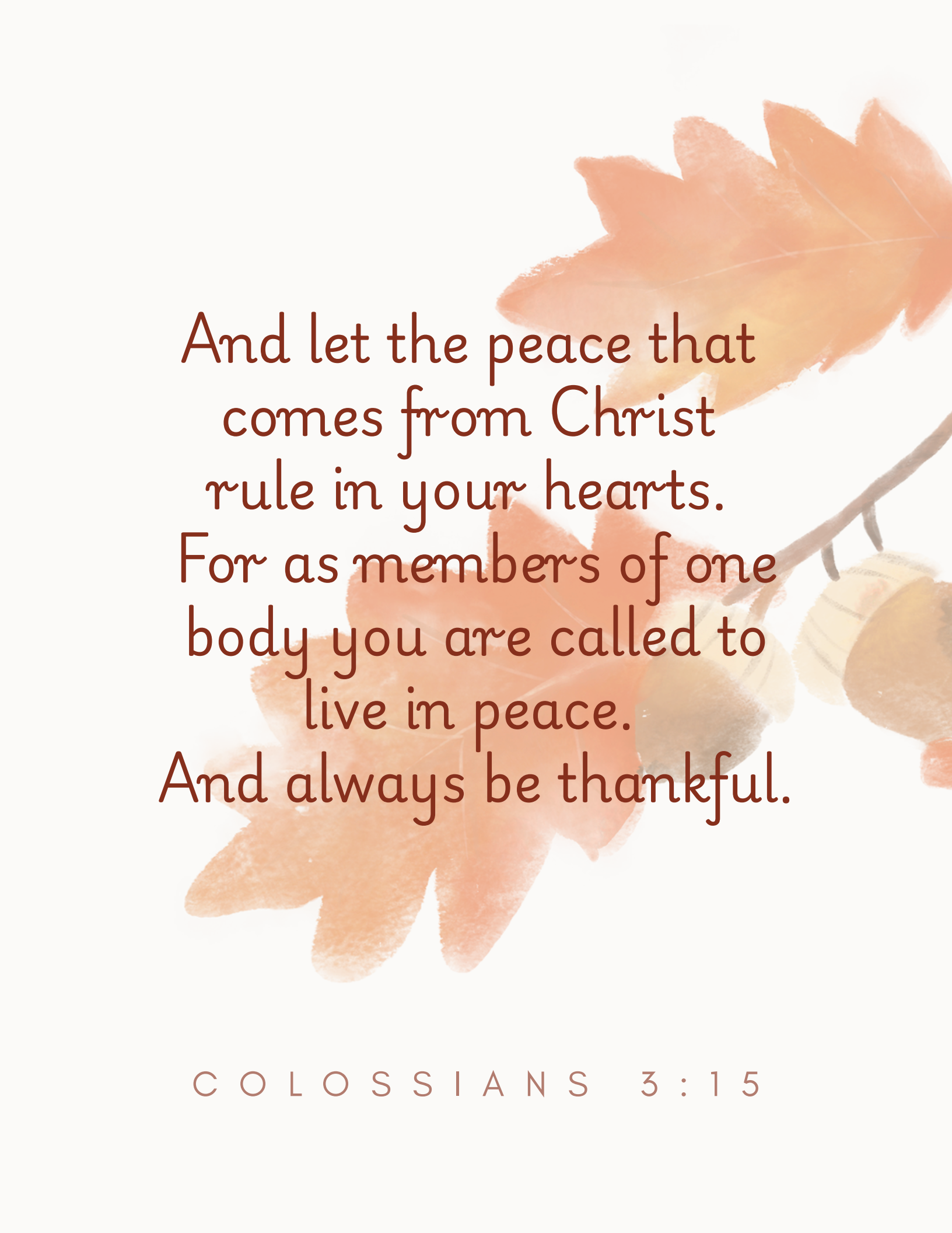

Re-Imagining Unity: John 17:20-26

Jesus' prayer for His followers reveals that unity is not something we construct but something we receive—a gift rooted in the very oneness of Father and Son. This divine unity is meant to be seen and experienced through the church so the world might glimpse the beauty of God's love. When believers live as one, the glory of God—His presence and character—is revealed; when we divide, that glory is obscured. Our unity is therefore more than agreement or organization; it is a spiritual communion shaped by divine love and sustained by humility.

In a world fractured by self-interest and competing visions of harmony, Jesus' prayer still asks the pressing question: how will the world know God's reality? It will be through a community whose love is stronger than difference, whose relationships mirror the mutual love of the Trinity. The church's witness depends not on institutional power or moral perfection, but on our willingness to live as one—complete, maturing, and joined in the divine life that Jesus prayed would dwell within us all.
