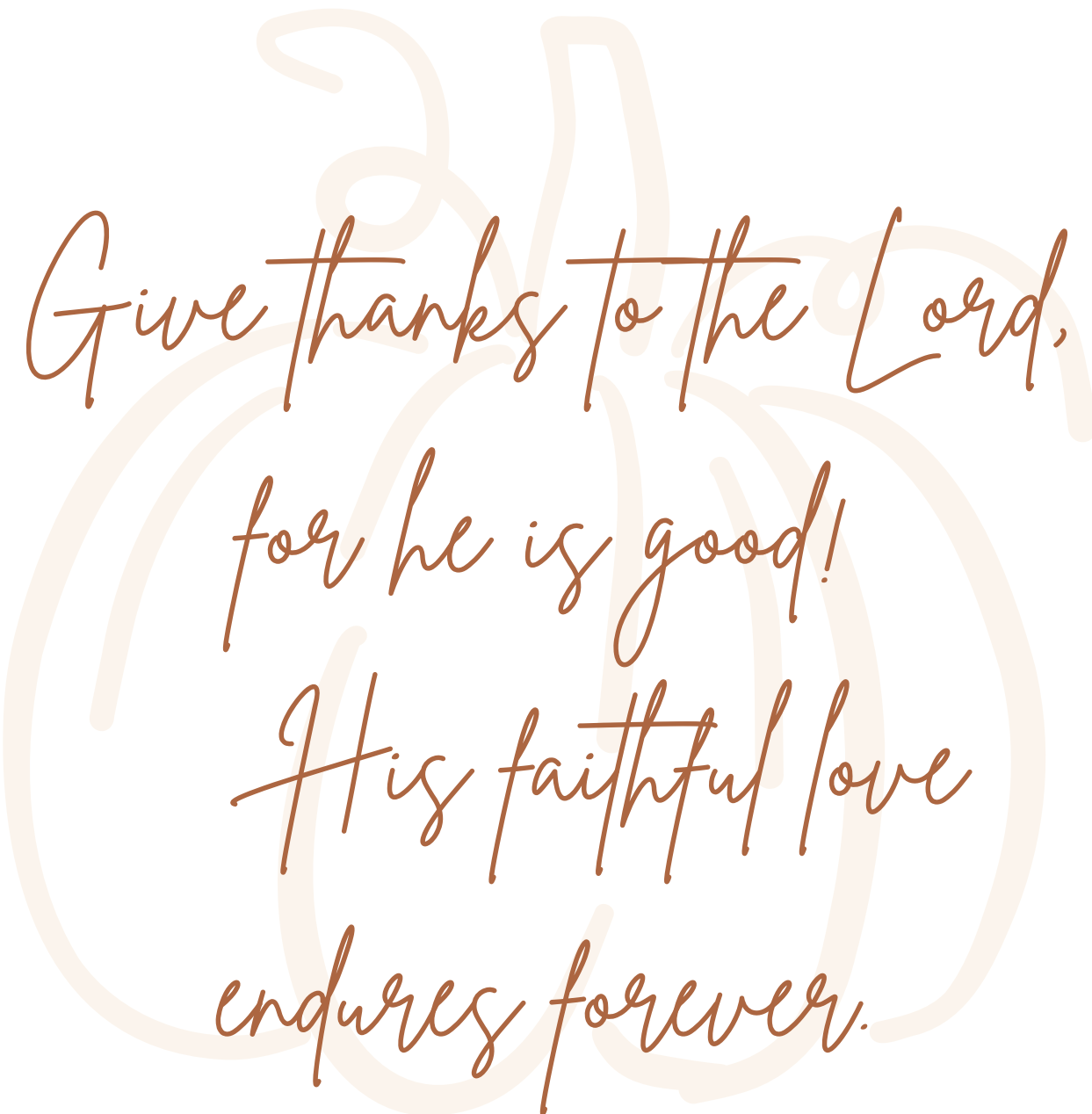

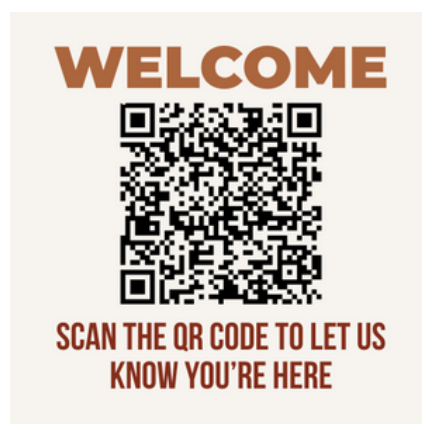
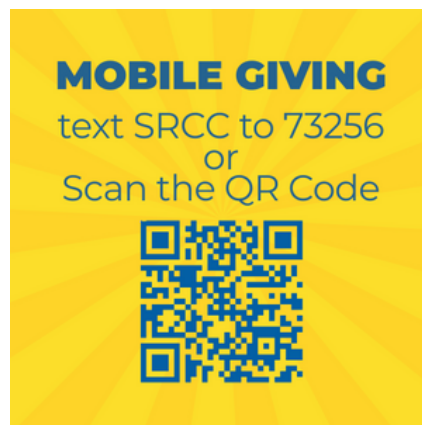

“Re-Imagining Death” (John 3:16)

In this sermon, we’re invited to see John 3:16 not as a sentimental slogan, but as a daring confession: “For God so loved the world that He died.” The cross is not merely a passageway to heaven but the place where love and death meet—where death itself “falls in love.” Jesus does not avoid the sorrow and brokenness of life; He enters it, transforming death into the doorway of life.

Too often, churches mirror a Hallmark world—bright, polished, and distant from real pain. Yet the Gospel calls us into the raw, untamed spaces of loss, grief, and despair, where God’s love still abides. True discipleship means facing death—the deaths of ego, comfort, and illusion—and discovering resurrection on the other side.

To belong to Christ’s church is to live truthfully, bringing our wounds, failures, and fears into His healing light. In a world obsessed with avoiding pain, this is the strange and beautiful truth: death has fallen in love—and love has conquered death.
