Advent: “They Will Come for Faithful Love.”

Jeremiah 31:3 & Jeremiah 3:20

This week’s Advent message invites us to pause, look inward, and prepare our hearts—not just our homes—for the coming of Christ. Advent reveals the wonder of God’s faithful, everlasting love entering our unfaithful and fragile human story. Scripture reminds us that while our love often fades like morning dew, God’s love remains steadfast, pursuing, and unchanging.

Through passages from Jeremiah, Psalms, Hosea, and 2 Timothy, we see the contrast between God’s unwavering devotion and our inconsistent responses. Yet the miracle of Advent is this: God does not wait for us to fix ourselves. He comes to us in love.

Advent calls us not to perform, but to behold; not to strive, but to receive. As we reflect on our broken offerings, we are invited to receive the faithful love of Christ—the love that reshapes our hearts and teaches us to love in return. May this season awaken us again to the astonishing gift of God’s unfailing love, a love that does not fade, fail, or give up.
