**JOURNEY TO THE CROSS:
(Ephesians 6:18/Genesis 16&21)
"Don't Pay to play...PRAY!"**

In Ephesians 6:18, Paul calls us to pray “at all times in the Spirit” – not with polished words or controlled outcomes, but with persevering dependence. Hagar’s cries in the wilderness in Genesis 16 and 21 show us this kind of prayer: raw, honest, stripped of status and self-sufficiency. With no power to fix her circumstances, she wept – and discovered the God who sees and hears. Her story reminds us that true prayer escapes formality and human control; it admits thirst, helplessness, and need. And in that surrendered place, God opens our eyes to wells we could not see.

Racism continues to be in the spotlight, and social media algorithms and echo chambers flood our news feeds with endless reasons for despair. Republican vs Democrat, Black vs White, Male vs Female, Rich vs Poor . . . but Solomon reminds us in Ecclesiastes that there is nothing new under the sun!

The Church of Jesus Christ is designed to be distinct from the world and be an attractive place that people of the world can be drawn to for a new way of life.

Our God is the great uniter, and we serve a risen savior who has overcome the trials and tribulations of this world. Every one of us is unique, but we were all made in the image of God. Galatians 3:26-28 says, "So in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith, for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus."

This unity in sonship and purpose does not mean that we will all think the same or have the same opinions or preferences. But it does mean that we can share the same vision of discipleship as we pursue God, each other and the world. We have all received the Great Commission of Matthew 28!

Ephesians 4:2-5 says "Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all."

Oneness of purpose and Spirit is what we want to focus our minds on. Oneness of service to our Father, each other, and this community is where we want to focus our energy. Oneness of outreach to a lost world must be our mission.

Proverbs 17:9 says, "Whoever would foster love covers over an offense, but whoever repeats the matter separates close friends." Proverbs 26:20 says, "Without wood a fire

goes out, without a gossip a quarrel dies down.” And Ephesians 4:29-32 says, “Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. Get rid of all bitterness, rage, and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as Christ God forgave you.”

These are God’s instructions on how to pursue unity. As we are called to oneness, we are called to be forgiving and not to engage in worthless and unwholesome talk. We are warned against repeatedly discussing a wrong that was forgiven. We are encouraged to speak directly to each other in a manner that is uplifting and beneficial.

We acknowledge that, in recent months and years, several from our church have chosen to worship elsewhere. We grieve those losses as we know you do. We recognize some of our current members are discouraged. We pray diligently for those who feel discouraged, uncomfortable, or concerned, and pray we can all have the patience and perseverance to see the blessings that God has in store for Saturn Road as we work towards unity. We have also added new members, and are thankful for the way they are finding their place of service and fellowship in the church. As we seek the Spirit’s leading, we are all aware that God’s timing is not ours, and the eSorts of your eldership aren’t always immediately obvious, but you can be assured that we are committed to addressing the cares and concerns of this body and are actively pursuing God’s plan for a way we can all feel at home as a family at Saturn Road and be a more eSective body for Christ that is a light to the world around us. We value each and every one of our family members and our honored guests and visitors here at Saturn Road.

We love you and pray for you continually! Please pray for Saturn Road as we follow the Spirit’s direction.
