Crying in the Wrong Place

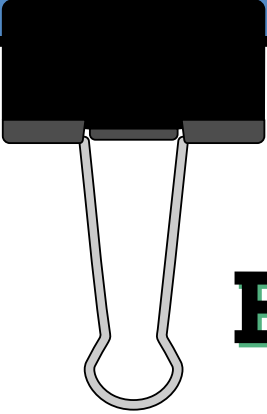
John 20:11–16

Mary Magdalene came to the tomb expecting death but encountered the risen Christ. Twice she is asked, "Why are you crying?" Her tears reveal that, despite following Jesus, she was still looking for a dead Savior instead of expecting resurrection.

This message explores how spiritual formation should shape our vision. As disciples who have learned from Jesus, we are called to live with resurrection expectation rather than despair. The risen Christ does not send us back to the tomb—He sends us into the world as witnesses of new life, hope, and transformation.

As followers of Jesus, are we commemorating lifeless things and ideas, or are we living as people who have been raised with Christ? Resurrection changes not only our future but how we see, live, and love today. The call is to move from crying to announcing the good news that Jesus is alive. We are in Christ... thus, everything we touch and every place we grace with our/HIS presence...should come alive!

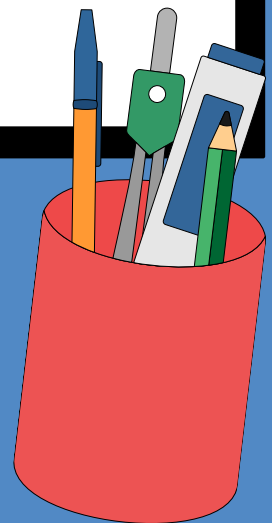
