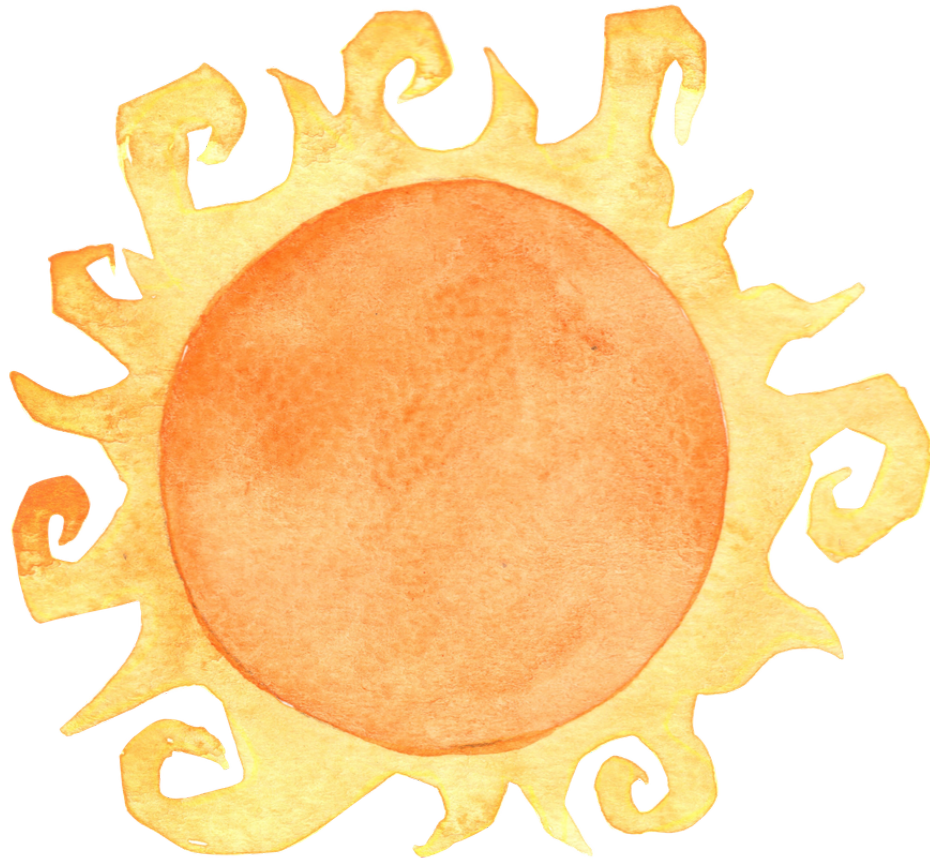

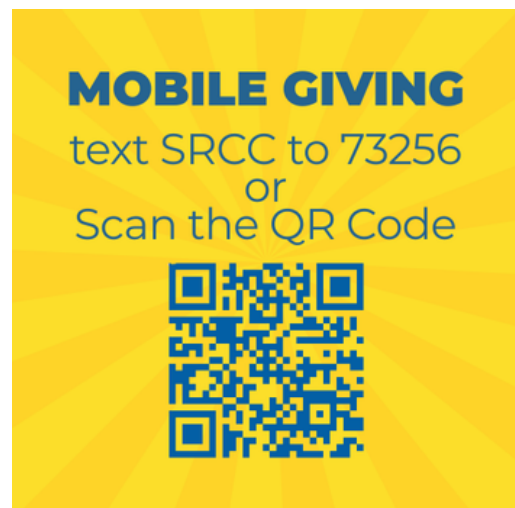
Sermon Series: The REAL Thing
(a mini-series on AI and the Gospel)
The Incarnation vs. the Algorithm
1 John 1:1-7

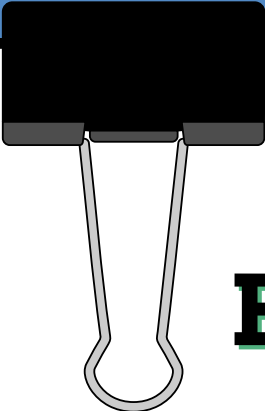
In a world where artificial intelligence can create convincing images, voices, and even "people," how do we discern what is real? John answers by pointing us to Jesus Christ—the One who was heard, seen, and touched. The gospel is not a virtual idea or a philosophy but the good news of the incarnate Son of God, revealed in flesh and experienced in real relationship.

As followers of Christ, we are called to embody that same reality. Truth is not merely something we post or proclaim; it is something we practice. In an age of algorithms and digital connections, people don't just need information about Jesus—they need to encounter His love through His people. The Church is called to be a living witness of authentic, sacrificial, forgiving, and tangible love.

This week, we'll consider what it means to be truly human in an increasingly artificial world and reject the "deep fake" versions of love and truth. Instead, we'll embrace the real, embodied life of Christ that brings light into the darkness.

Note to congregation: It would be a great idea to read 1st, 2nd, and 3rd John in preparation for the sermons.

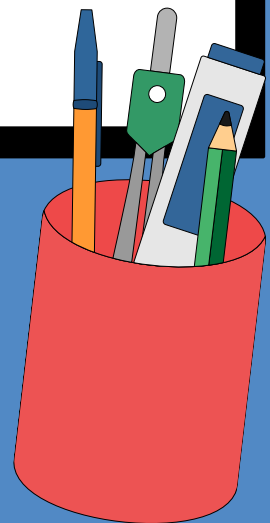
