Hebrews 5:7-12: Moving (suffering) Past the Welcome Center

Why does a loving God allow us to experience pain? New and mature believers alike often struggle to find purpose in difficult seasons. This week, we dive into Hebrews 5 to discover that suffering is not a sign of God's absence, but rather a passport into deeper intimacy with Him.

Even Jesus, the Son of God, learned obedience and was perfected through the things He suffered. His cries and tears drove Him away from self-reliance and straight into a profound dependence on the Father.

When we avoid the heavy seasons of life, we end up spiritually stunted—stuck at the "welcome center" of Christianity, drinking milk instead of eating solid food. God invites us to move past the entrances and exits and step into the actual stadium of a deeply formed spiritual life.

Your suffering is a refining fire. It shapes you into an authentic, experienced guide who can confidently lead others through their own valleys. This week, we are called to learn how to embrace the interior journey...to stop running from the hard questions, and allow God to transform our pain into a powerful ministry for others.

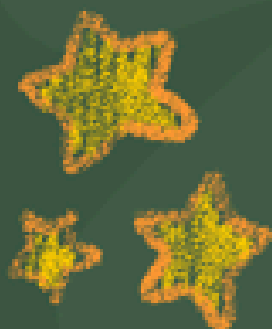

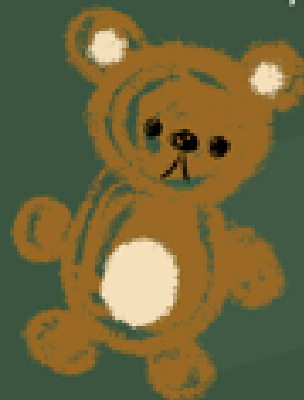

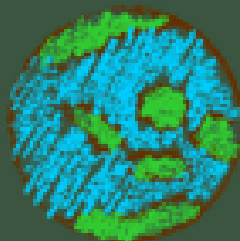
